

VScroll Marquee Tutorial

Instructions for operating the scrolling marquee

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Overview

The self-updateable scrolling marquee can be used to alert visitors of new information on your website. Using basic HTML, you can create links to any webpage. You may also use the marquee to convey news, events and more!

Adding Items to the Marquee

The lines of text scrolling in your marquee are called *Items*. To add an item, click [Add Items](#). Fill in the fields as shown.

Delay: Enter a whole number in this field to tell the marquee how long it should show this item before scrolling to the next item. If all marquee items have a delay of 0, no pauses will occur as the marquee scrolls. A delay of 5 will pause the item on the marquee for 5 seconds before scrolling to the next item.

Enter the text you would like to add to the marquee here: Enter text for the item that will appear on your marquee. You can use basic HTML; see the reverse of this tutorial for HTML help.

Add This Item After: This drop-down menu contains a list of the items in your marquee. Selecting "At the top" will put your new item first in the marquee's list. Selecting the title of an item will put your new item after the item you have selected.

Click **Save your text** to add the item to your marquee. The item will go live immediately; be sure to check spelling and punctuation before making the item live!

Adding Images to Marquee Items

Using simple HTML, you can add images to the items that scroll in your marquee. The image must be online so you can create a link to it. If you can't upload images to your website, please contact us to have the image uploaded.

To add an image to a marquee item, use an image tag in the text entry box:

The address to the image goes between the quotation marks in the tag.

Editing and Deleting Items

To modify or delete existing marquee items, click [View/Edit/Delete Items](#). A list of the items in your marquee will appear.

To remove an item, click [Delete](#) next to the item. Be sure you want to delete the item; deleted items cannot be reactivated!

To edit the content of an item, click [Edit](#) next to the item.

You will be able to edit any of the features shown under **Adding Items to the Marquee** on the first page of this tutorial.

HTML Quick Reference

To have these effects appear on your marquee, copy the tag and replace the content in **red**.

Bold: `text between these tags will appear bold`

Italic: `<i>text between these tags will appear italic</i>`

Email Link: `johndoe@domain.com`

After the mailto:, enter your email address.

Enter it again between the `>`.

This will appear as the text of your link: johndoe@domain.com

Page Link: `About Us`

Enter the page name between the " "

Enter the page name between the `>`. Text entered here will appear as the page name in your marquee: [About Us](#)

When creating links to external websites, you must write the domain like this:

`Website Name`

The target="new" will cause the external website to open in a new browser window.

Some characters in HTML must be written with special codes:

`&` = `&`; Example: *Thank you & come again* must be written as *Thank you & come again*

`"` = `"`; Example: *Our new "Specials"* must be written as *Our new "Specials"*
