1. For New Install: after s	starting Mailapp for the first time, the Mail client setup screen will	open.

2. Fill in the fields as shown to create an email account:

Full Name: Enter a full name for the account (i.e. Joe Smith, ABC Co. Human Resources). This name will appear as the "From" name in the recipient's email client.

E-Mail Address: Enter your entire email address

Incoming Mail Server: Enter <u>imap.yourdomain.com</u>, replacing "yourdomain.com" with the domain of your website. For example, if your domain is "xyzinc.com," you would enter "imap.xyzinc.com."

Account Type: Set to IMAP

User Name: Enter your entire email address

Password: Enter the password for this email account

Outgoing Mail Server: Enter in the SMTP server for your Internet Service Provider in the Outgoing Server box. A list of some ISP's SMTP servers can be found at:

3. Click **OK** to complete email setup.

1. To Add Additional Accounts: Click on Mail > Preferences > Accounts to access email setup.
